3. **John 20:31:** But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.
4. **Psalm 23:1-3a:** The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet water, He restores my soul.
5. **Psalm 23:3b- 4:** He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
6. **Psalm 23: 5:** You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.
7. **Psalm 23: 6:** Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
8. **Genesis 3:15:** I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; He will crush your head and you will strike His heel.
9. **The First Commandment:** You shall have no other gods. What does this mean (WDTM)? We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.
10. **Psalm 14:1:** The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good.
11. **The Second Commandment:** You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
12. **Isaiah 9:6:** To us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
13. **The Third Commandment:** Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.
14. **Joshua 1:8:** Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it.

15. **The Fourth Commandment:** Honor your father and your mother. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

Colossians 3:20: Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.
17. **The Fifth Commandment:** You shall not murder. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.
18. **Ephesians 4:29:** Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
19. **The Sixth Commandment:** You shall not commit adultery. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.
20. **Philippians 4:8:** Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable- if anything is excellent or praiseworthy- think about such things.
21. **The Seventh Commandment:** You shall not steal. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.
22. **Ephesians 4:28:** He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need.
23. **The Eighth Commandment:** You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
24. **Matthew 18:15:** If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you.
25. **The Ninth Commandment:** You shall not covet your neighbor's house. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's

inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

26. **The Tenth Commandment:** You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. WDTM? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
27. **Luke 12:15:** He said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."
28. **The Close of the Commandments: What does God say about these commandments?** He says: "I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love Me and keep My Commandments." [Exodus 20:5-6]
29. **WDTM?** God threatens to punish all those who break these commandments. Therefore, we should fear His wrath and not do anything against them. But He promises grace and every blessing to all who keep these commandments. Therefore, we should also love and trust in Him and gladly do what He commands.
30. **Matthew 10:28:** Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.
31. **Psalms 119:9:** How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to Your word.
32. **The First Article:** I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. WDTM? I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them.
33. He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life.
34. He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him. This is most certainly true.

35. **Hebrews 11:3:** By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.
36. **Matthew 6:33-34:** But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.
37. **The Second Article:** I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. 40. **Galatians 4:4-5:** When the time had fully come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.
41. **The Third Article:** I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen. **WDTM?** I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith.
42. In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. 48. **Romans 6:3-4:** Don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
49. **1 John 1:8-9:** If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
50. **Matthew 5:23-24:** If you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.
51. **1 Peter 2:9:** You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.
52. **Romans 8:38-39:** I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
53. **John 15:5:** I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in Me and I in him he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing.
54. **Romans 8:31-32:** If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all- how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?
